The child is a high risk of Persistent Absence.

Stage 3 letter sent to parents. Attendance Meeting with family. Review of AIP, early help and other intervention programmes. Consider the support of external services.

All avenues have been exhausted and support is not working or not being engaged with. Attendance Meeting with the AHT and Family. EWO Guidance &

All support, and offer of support, to be reviewed. Continued support of the child and family.

The school will seek advise from the LEA.

16 sessions's

absence

Support

academically through regular school attendance. Students are rewarded for high attendance.

Concerning levels of child absence.

Internal monitoring. Trigger 1 letter sent to parents. Meeting with **RAISE** Tutor to explore barriers

Serious concerns regarding attendance.

Stage 2 letter sent to parents. Attendance Intervention Lead supports student. Possible early help support offered.
