HERE EVERYDAY READY ON TIME

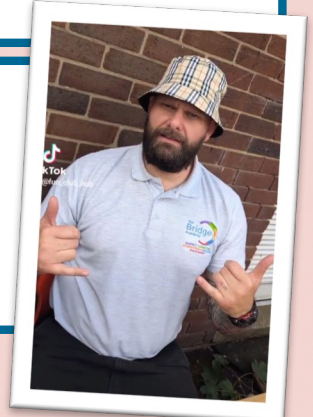
